Providing SUBLOCADE®

SUBLOCADE® is available only through a restricted distribution program called the SUBLOCADE® REMS Program. Prescribers can obtain SUBLOCADE® for their patients in one of two ways:

Providers can order SUBLOCADE® directly through a distributor:

To order SUBLOCADE® directly through an authorized distributor, providers must practice in a healthcare setting that is REMS certified. See the REMS certification section below for details on how to obtain REMS certification.

Providers can order SUBLOCADE® through a certified pharmacy for a specific patient:

- In advance of the patient's appointment, providers must send a prescription for a named patient to a certified pharmacy.
- The certified pharmacy will send SUBLOCADE® to either the prescribing practitioner or the practitioner administering the controlled substance, as applicable, to administer directly to that patient.
- This method of provision DOES NOT require your healthcare setting to be certified in the SUBLOCADE® REMS Program. A list of certified pharmacies can be found here.

BECOMING REMS CERTIFIED:

In order to become REMS certified, providers must do the following:

- Designate an authorized representative.
- ➤ The authorized representative will ensure that each dispensing location meets the REMS requirements and is eligible to purchase, receive, and dispense SUBLOCADE®.
- Complete, sign, and submit the <u>SUBLOCADE® REMS Program Healthcare Setting</u> and <u>Pharmacy Enrollment Form</u>.
- Implement the REMS program.
- ➤ Establish processes and procedures to verify that SUBLOCADE® is dispensed directly to a healthcare provider for administration to a patient.
- Implement the necessary staff training and processes to comply with these processes and procedures.
