TO CREATE A NEW PATIENT REQUEST

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <PATIENT REQUEST>
- ◆ Input required fields: FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, DOB (mm/dd/yyyy)

WANT TO SEARCH IN OTHER STATES?

Check the box(es) next to the desired state(s) under 'PMP InterConnect Search'

Only delegates with proper credentials (i.e., LPN, RN) are authorized to search in select states (e.g., Georgia)

CAN'T FIND PATIENT OR WANT TO EXPAND SEARCH?

Check required fields for errors. If there is no error:

- ◆ Enter the patient zip code (identifies most patients with hyphenated names or names that contain a suffix [e.g., Jr., Sr.])
OR
Use partial spelling option (check partial spelling box and enter first 3 letters of first and/or last name)
- ◆ If more than one first or last name, run multiple patient requests (e.g., one for Smith-Doe and one for Doe-Smith)

* Controlled medications dispensed at Department of Defense (DOD) facilities; Veterans Administration facilities report to individual state PDMPs

MULTIPLE PATIENTS FOUND?

If multiple patients found that match the search criteria:

- ◆ Be sure to move/scroll sidebar, if present, to view all patient groups
- ◆ To complete patient request, check the boxes next to the patient group(s) that may represent your patient, then click <RUN REPORT>
 - *Be sure to ONLY SELECT the patient records of the patient you intended to search*
- ◆ To modify search criteria before completing the patient request, click <REFINE SEARCH CRITERIA>

TO SEARCH FOR MULTIPLE PATIENTS AT ONE TIME

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <BULK PATIENT SEARCH>
- ◆ Input required fields: FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, DOB (mm/dd/yyyy) and click <ADD>, then repeat
- ◆ Input a Group Name (e.g., date), then click <SEARCH>
- ◆ Scroll to the top and click <BULK PATIENT HISTORY>
- ◆ Select Group Name
- ◆ Click desired patient row, then click <VIEW> to view the report; repeat for each patient you wish to view

TO RUN AN UPDATED PATIENT REQUEST (i.e., rerun a previous patient request for today's date)

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <REQUESTS HISTORY>
- ◆ Click <ADVANCED OPTIONS>, then enter desired field (e.g., last name)
- ◆ Click <SEARCH>, then select patient of interest by clicking anywhere on row and click <REFRESH>
- ◆ Check 'I agree to the terms of the acknowledgment', then click <SEARCH>

Note: Your request history is maintained for up to 6 years

TO VIEW PRESCRIPTIONS YOU WROTE DURING A SPECIFIC TIME PERIOD

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <MyRx>
- ◆ Enter chosen date range for the search
- ◆ Check box(es) next to DEA numbers you wish to search
- ◆ Click <SEARCH>

Note: For best results, do not enter a drug name and choose a date range no longer than one month

TIPS AND TRICKS FOR REVIEWING SCRIPTS NARX REPORTS

HOW TO PRINT A NARX REPORT

NEW QUICK PRINT OPTION FOR CONDENSED NARX REPORT

When viewing a patient's Narx report, click <PDF Report> to download and generate the new condensed printable version that excludes the communications tab, charts, and graphs.

◆ Be sure to print in the default portrait mode

Messages

The Messages feature allows you to send a private message to another prescriber that is listed on the patient record

Care Notes feature allows you to flag additional clinically relevant information in the patient record that everyone can see

To add note: Click 'Add Note', and select one of the predefined Care Notes. Then select desired expiration from drop-down menu (default is 'never expire')

Care Notes are read-only for delegates

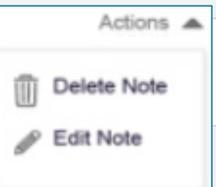

TIPS AND TRICKS FOR REVIEWING SCRIPTS NARX REPORTS [CONT'D]

Narx Scores are calculated based on amount of medication dispensed, number of prescribers, number of pharmacies, and overlapping prescriptions

Overdose Risk Score (ORS) is intended to be a predictive score for unintentional overdose death

NEW CLINICAL ALERT FEATURE

Narx Scores

Narcotic **300** Sedative **180** Stimulant **000**

The last number in a Narx Score indicates the number of active prescriptions in that class

State Indicators (5)

- ! Daily Active MME ≥ 90
- ! Overlapping Opioid & Benzodiazepine
- ! ≥ 5 Prescribers in 90 days
- ! ≥ 5 Dispensers in 90 days
- ! Naloxone Administered

State Indicator Clinical Alerts include:

- ≥ 90 MME/day
- Any opioid or benzodiazepine dispensed within the same overlapping time period
- ≥ 5 prescribers or ≥ 5 pharmacies (dispensers) within a 90 day period
- Naloxone administration reported by EMS, first responders, or major healthcare facilities in South Carolina (patient must have controlled substance filled within searched time frame [default 2 years] for alert to populate)

TIPS AND TRICKS FOR REVIEWING PRESCRIBER REPORT

PRESCRIBER REPORTS NOW DISPLAY PATIENT RECORDS FOR EACH METRIC WHEN YOU LOG INTO YOUR SCRIPTS ACCOUNT

- ◆ Click <MENU> then <PRESCRIBER REPORT> to open your report
- ◆ Click the number under the metric within the Unique Patient Categories to see individual patient records associated with the metric

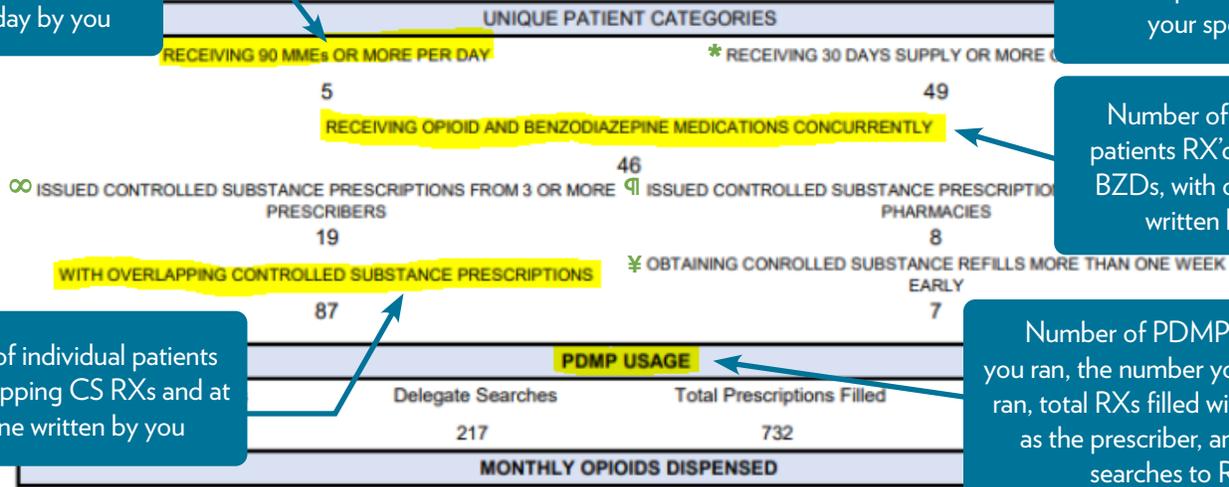

Blue square is your data. Grey square is the median value of prescribers within your specialty



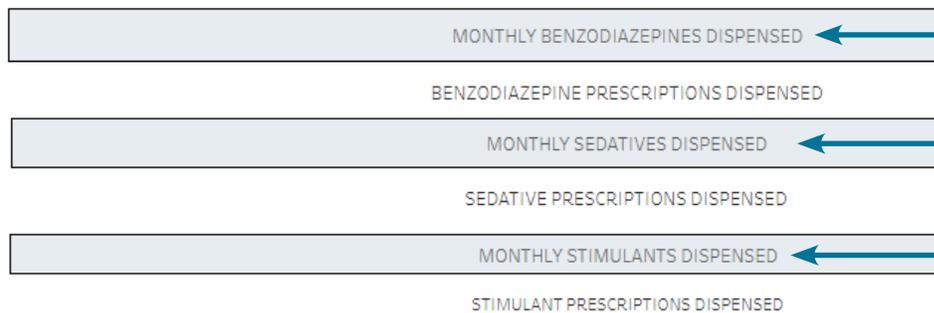
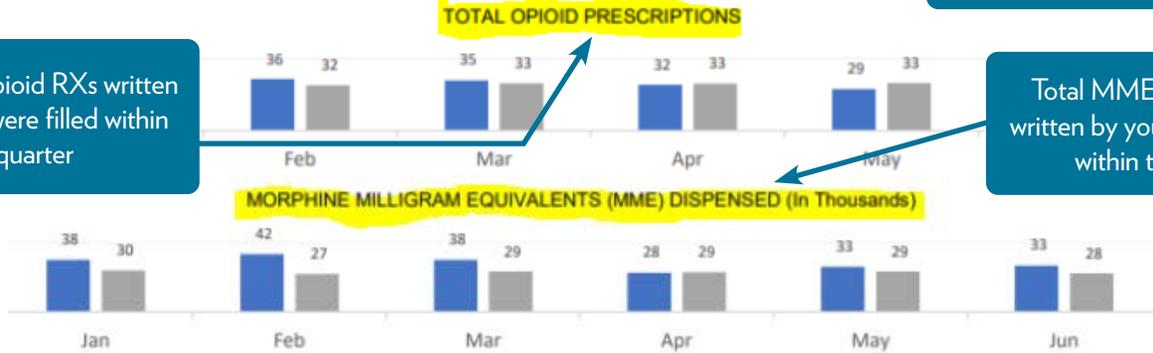
Number of individual patients with overlapping CS RXs and at least one written by you

Prescriber must be registered in the SCRIPTS database & have written for at least one controlled substance in the previous six months to have a report generated
